**Basic Contributions**

Students completing the C bundle of assignments must make basic contributions to the simulation.

Basic contributions require regular attendance and participation in simulation activities. This includes assisting with your committee's work. Any student that misses more than 2 LegSim days (including days on the course schedule during which parties or committees are scheduled to meet) will not earn credit for contributing to the simulation. **Substantial Contributions**

Students completing the A and B bundles must do all of the things listed under Basic contributions and, further, make substantial contributions.

Legislators can contribute substantially in different ways. Some possible forms of participation include introducing legislation (above the minimum requirement), offering amendments to other students' bills, writing Dear Colleague letters, participating in debates, serving as a party or committee leader, using your knowledge of LegSim procedures to make appropriate motions during debate, creating a caucus, and lobbying other members to support (or defeat) legislation according to your preferences.
